QUICK-START

MEDER BasicGuide mini

Switch on

Press the (0) switch.

If no speech is made for 5 minutes, MicSens flashes on the display. After a further 25 minutes, the transmitter switches off automatically.

Select channel

Use the channel buttons to select the desired transmission channel.

If several transmitters are in use at the same time, if possible keep at least 1 channel - ideally 2 channels between the channels in use.


Remote channel setting You transmit the selected channel to the receiver devices by pressing the (R) button while the transmitter is pointing towards the front of the receiver.

> A distance of 1 meter must not be exceeded. If the transmission was successful, the diode lights up red three times quickly.

The correct microphone sensitivity ensures ideal sound quality for the receiver.



The sensitivity adjustment is active when the symbol is shown on the display is shown.



The **Noisegate** function ensures that unwanted background noise is not transmitted when the guide is not speaking.

It can be activated or deactiva-on the display.

To apply the changed functions, switch off the the device by pressing the (0) button. As soon as the device is switched on again, the changes will take effect.

Microphone

Insert the headphone plug into the socket provided. If the connection was successful, the diode lights up red three times quickly.


Adjust volume
